

Exams Registration Policy

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that all child or young persons who wish to sit for exams are able to do so in a fair and efficient manner. This policy will provide guidelines for registering for exams and the responsibilities of both children or young people and the educational institution.

This policy applies to all children or young people who are enrolled in any course or program at the educational institution.

- 1. Eligibility: Children or young people must meet all the eligibility criteria set by the educational institution to register for exams. These criteria may include, but are not limited to, meeting the minimum attendance requirements, completing all required coursework, and paying all necessary fees.
- 2. Registration process: Children or young people must register for exams during the registration period set by the educational institution. The registration process may include completing a registration form, paying a registration fee, and providing relevant documents to prove eligibility.
- 3. Withdrawals: Children and young people who wish to withdraw from an exam must notify the educational institution in writing before the registration deadline. A partial or full refund may be provided, depending on the timing of the withdrawal and the policies of the educational institution.
